**Resolution 1** - Resolutions taken on the previous meeting were read. Due to the unprecedented Lockdown Resolution 3 (department wise educational exhibition) and Resolution 4 (registration of the alumni association) could not be materialized. Rest of the resolutions were confirmed.

**Resolution 2** – Keeping the neo-normal situation in mind, during the ongoing Lockdown situation, due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, when the entire Teaching-Learning process has been switched to online mode, the Department of Economics has proposed, in collaboration with the IQAC, to organize a National-Level Essay Writing Competition for students, on the Socio-Economic Impact of the Lockdown, during 13 to 20<sup>th</sup> July, 2020. Resolved unanimously that the IQAC will extend wholehearted support to this endeavour.

**Resolution 3** – The Department of English has also proposed to organize, in collaboration with the IQAC, a National Webinar on the Cross-Cultural Perspectives of the Renaissance on 30/07/2020. The IQAC resolves to extend similar cooperation to the effort.
