The following resolutions were taken unanimously after discussion on the itemized agenda mentioned in the notice (Ref no KSM/IQAC/02/2021, dated 25/07/2021):

Resolution 1 - Resolutions taken on the previous meeting were read and confirmed.

Resolution 2 – Regarding the process of completing, uploading and mailing the AQAR and supporting data, the Coordinator informed that the raw data collected by Prof P. Pal from the Students' Feedback on all aspects of teaching and learning need to be finalized in the form of a chart/diagram.
