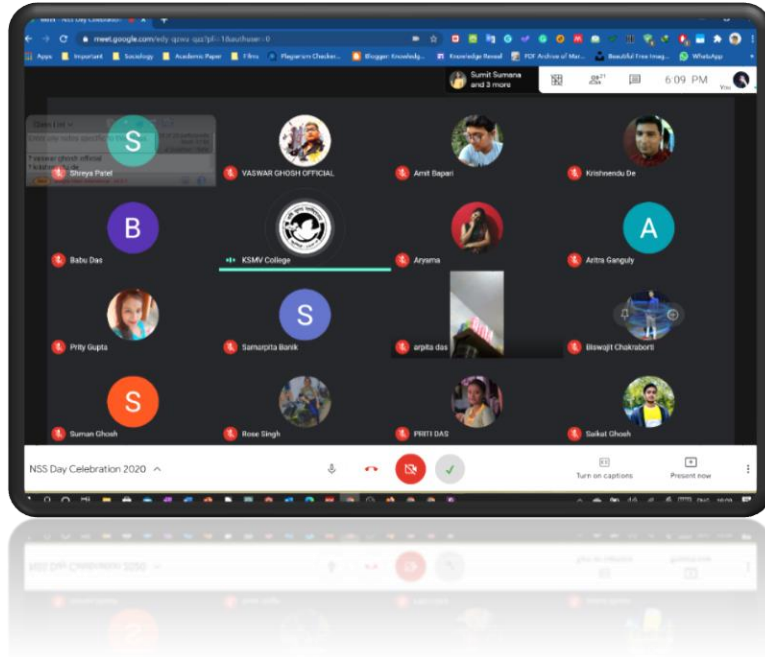
REPORT

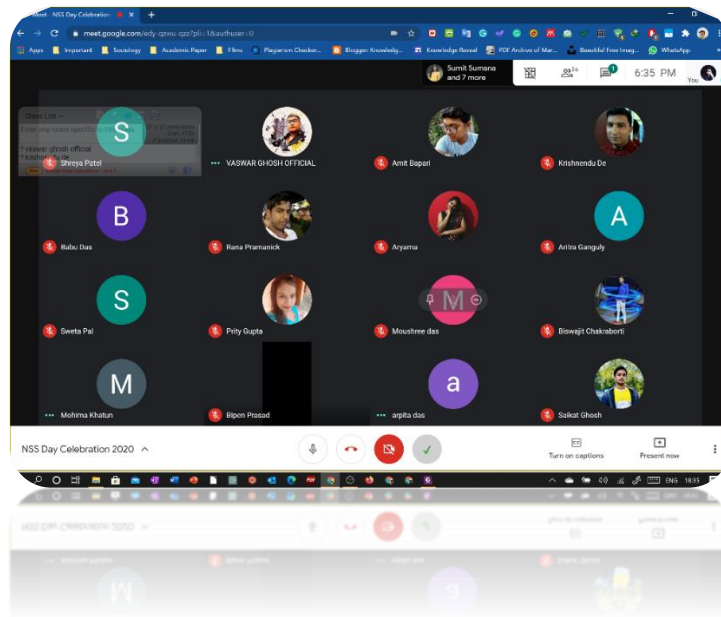
